

HOW TO SUBMIT A CASE WHEN MANUALLY UPLOADING IMAGES

- 1) Place your images (must be jpeg or Dicom files and not shortcuts; pdf is ok for bloodwork or ECG) on the desktop of your computer, or in another easily accessible location on the computer (NOT on a removable drive).
- 2) Log in to <u>www.antechimagingservices.com</u> by entering your Username and Password in the upper right-hand corner fields and clicking Go.



3) Click the PACS tab on the left side of the blue bar at the top, and choose "Store Images".

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4) Enter the patient's information. In the clinic/case number selection use the hospital's unique patient id to ensure previous/future cases will link together correctly for this patient.

- 5) If you have previous images for this patient, you may choose that patient on the 2nd page. If not, complete the patient information by entering Date of Birth and Sex of the patient.
- 6) On the final page ("Uploaded Media for [Patient name]"), "Click Here" to start uploading media. After installing the Aspera Connect plugin if needed, you will have a Media Upload window appear. You may Drag-and-Drop your desired files into this box, or choose Upload Files to find your desired files. Once all images have been added, click Done Uploading.
- 7) Back on the Uploaded Media for (Patient name) page, click Back to PACS at the bottom.

8) Click "Go" at the bottom of the Search Options box to bring up images taken within the past 7 days; adjust your search date range and enter patient information as needed to find your desired images.

- 9) Find the patient for which you wish to send for a consult and click the icon or choose Submit a Consult from the Select Action bar.
- 10) Ensure the patient information is correct and complete, or edit as needed. IMPORTANT please be sure species, breed, sex (including intact vs. neutered) and date of birth are as accurate as possible.
- 11) Select the "Referring General Practitioner" from the pulldown at the top of the form.
- 12) For a STAT consult select the "STAT" option from the turnaround time pulldown.
